- We need to consult Cara about what's needed the most: safe space seating, safety locks, visual clocks.
 - According to Cara, some sensory consumables & the safety locks have recently been purchased, but we could consider some wall-mounted tactile panels for the new gross motor room. The committee briefly chatted about purchasing crash mats & a padded slide, however if the room is no longer available in the future, storage may be an issue - it may be better to work with what we have.
 - We should take this question to the EAs
 - Wipeable bean bag chairs were suggested
